<p><b>7</b> Ask the Lord to strengthen those pastors who spoke out for Sanctity of Life Sunday. <i>The eyes of the Lord range throughout the earth to strengthen those whose hearts are totally committed to Him. (2Chron. 16:9)</i></p>	<p><b>8</b> Pray for the Truth Project, Senate Room 25 Mondays at 10, and for a LUV Iowa activation event today in Burlington. <i>You are right in saying I am a king. In fact, for this reason I was born, and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth. (John 18:37)</i></p>	<p><b>9 prayer at the Capitol</b> Ask God for His power in our prayer meetings, and that a Luv Iowa Activation group would form in Council Bluffs. <i>After they prayed, the room where they were meeting was shaken. (Acts 4:31)</i></p>	<p><b>10</b> Ask God to energize 2010 candidates with truth and physical needs. <i>I consider my life worth nothing to me, if only I may finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me.... (Psalm 30:1)</i></p>	<p><b>12</b> Pray for Marriage Matters fundraisers tonight and tomorrow. <i>He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also...enlarge the harvest of your righteousness. (2Cor. 9:10)</i></p>	<p><b>13</b> Ask the Father to come into the homes of his people...to cleanse and renew. <i>Let us draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us... (1Peter 2:9)</i></p>	<p><b>15</b> Plead with the Lord to send more legislators and staff to the Truth Project. <i>Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth. (John 17:17)</i></p>	<p><b>16 prayer at the Capitol</b> Ask God to raise up even more candidates who love their families and their Lord — before the mid-March filing date. <i>Therefore my dear brothers, stand firm. Let nothing move you. (1Cor. 15:58)</i></p>	<p><b>17</b> Pray we will hear the cries of the 4,000 children who will be aborted in America today. <i>If you say, "But we knew nothing about this," does not he who weighs the heart perceive it? (Ps. 42:2)</i></p>	<p><b>22 Monthly noon worship at the Capitol</b> Pray for the gathering! <i>I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being.... (Eph 3:14-19)</i></p>	<p><b>23 prayer at the Capitol</b> Ask the Lord to instill his boldness in legislators who revere his name. <i>In all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. (Rom. 8:37)</i></p>	<p><b>24</b> Ask the Lord to protect members of the media who tell the truth. <i>I have sought your face with all my heart; be gracious to me according to your promise. (Ps. 119:58)</i></p>	<p><b>25</b> Pray for God's choice in Iowa's gubernatorial candidate. <i>You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit.... (John 15:16)</i></p>	<p><b>26</b> Pray for transparency in the state budget. <i>Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account. (Heb. 4:13)</i></p>	<p><b>27</b> Plead with the Lord for more workers, and rest for those who work now. <i>Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ.
